<p>Voortspruitend uit 'n spesiale SKBR-vergadering gehou op 25 Junie 2015 om 20:00, het die Staat as werkgewer aangedui dat SKBR Resolusie 2 van 2015 soos onderteken deur Arbeid ten volle geïmplementeer sal word.</p> <p>Dit sluit die volgende in (verwys na Nasionale Nuusbrief 23/2015):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Algemene salarisaanpassing van 7%• Familie verantwoordelikhedsverlof• Vaderskapverlof• Mediese subsidie• Keuse tov betalingsdatum van diensbonus. <p>Die verskil van 0.6% op die algemene salarisaanpassing sal reflekteer op die Julie-salarisse van werknemers terugwerkend vanaf 1 April 2015.</p> <p>Die Staat het aangedui dat die volle implementering van SKBR Resolusie 2 van 2015 teen die einde van Julie 2015 gefinaliseer behoort te wees.</p> <p>Lede sal op hoogte gehou word rakende verwickelinge mbt bogenoemde prosesse.</p>	<p>Resulting from a special PSCBC meeting held at 20:00 on 25 June 2015, the State as employer indicated that PSCBC Resolution 2 of 2015, as signed by Labour, will be fully implemented.</p> <p>This includes the following (refer to National Newsletter 23/2015):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• General salary adjustment of 7%• Family responsibility leave• Paternity leave• Medical subsidy• Choice wrt payment date of service bonus. <p>The difference of 0.6% on the general salary adjustment will be reflected on the July salaries of employees, backdated from 1 April 2015.</p> <p>The State has indicated that the full implementation of the PSCBC Resolution 2 of 2015 should be finalised by the end of July 2015.</p> <p>Members will be kept abreast of developments regarding the above processes.</p>
