NTA Awards

SAOU lede het weer by die jaarlikse Nasionale Onderwyserstoekenningsaand (NTA) uitblink. Twee van ons lede het eerste plekke behaal na die landswye beoordeling. Me Hannelie Louw

SAOU members once again excelled at the annual National Teacher Awards evening (NTA). Two of our members won first place after the nationwide review. Ms Hannelie Louw (North-West Province)

(Noordwes) is in die kategorie Spesiale Onderwys as wenner aangewys, terwyl Me Lezanne de Beer (Noordwes) as kategoriewenner in die afdeling Graad R Onderwys geseëvier het. Albei het 'n Renault KWID motor ontvang asook verskeie ander pryse. Dit was voorwaar besondere prestasies.

Die volgende lede het verskeie geld- en opleidingspryse ter waarde van duisende rande ontvang:

- Me Arlene Holding (Noordwes Provinsie) het 'n tweede plek in die afdeling Lewenslange toewyding in die onderwys ontvang.
- Me Pulane Selina Motlough (Vrystaat) en me Louise Fullard (Mpumalanga) het albei derde plekke in onderskeidelik Laerskool Onderwys en Hoërskool Onderwys ontvang.

Elk van die 10 kategorieë waarvolgens beoordeel is, het 9 kandidate gehad wat as wenners in hul onderskeie provinsies aangewys is. Hulle het dan weer in die finale rondte teen mekaar te staan gekom. Die kompetisie was dus straf.

was named winner in the Special Education category, while Ms Lezanne de Beer (North-West Province) won the Grade R Education section. Both received a Renault KWID car as well as several other prizes. These were two exceptional achievements.

The following members received several money and training prizes worth thousands of rands:

- Ms Arlene Holding (North West Province) received a second place in the Lifetime Commitment in Education section.
- Ms Pulane Selina Motlough (Free State Province) and Ms Louise Fullard (Mpumalanga Province) received third places in Primary School and High School Education, respectively.

Each of the 10 categories adjudicated for the Awards had 9 candidates nominated as winners in each of the nine provinces. The nominees then all competed against each other again in the final round. The competition was thus stringent.

We wish to congratulate all the SAOU members who performed well above the average and who thus won prizes.
