

**SARO – Limpopo kantoor****SACE – Limpopo office**

SARO (SACE) het 'n volle funksionerende kantoor in Polokwane geopen. Volgens hulle woordvoerder sal hulle vanaf 1 Junie 2019 ten volle kan funksioneer. Hulle kantore is tans gehuisves by HTS Tom Naudé. SAOU (Limpopo) kon tot dusver nog nie die kontakbesonderhede van die kantoor verkry nie, maar sodra dit beskikbaar is sal dit aan die lede deurgegee word.

Die SARO kantoor in Polokwane sal al die funksies vervul wat tot op hede slegs by hulle hoofkantoor in Centurion beskikbaar was. Lede in Limpopo sal dus glad nie meer na Pretoria hoef te reis om SARO registrasie ens te doen nie.

SACE has opened a fully functioning office in Polokwane. According to their spokesman, they will be able to function fully from 1 June 2019. Their offices are currently located at HTS Tom Naudé. SAOU (Limpopo) has so far not been able to obtain the contact details of the office, but as soon as it is available it will be communicated to the members.

The SARO office in Polokwane will fulfil all the functions that have only been available at their Centurion headquarters to date. Limpopo members will no longer have to travel to Pretoria to do SACE registration etc.

Departementele eksamens**Common Exams**

SAOU (Limpopo) het verskeie navrae ontvang rakende departementele eksamens. Dit blyk dat sekere distrikte besluit het dat hierdie eksamens verpligtend is vir alle skole. Dit is bloot nie waar nie. Slegs onderpresterende skole kan verplig word om hierdie eksamens te skryf. Aangeheg is 'n skrywe van die departement wat dit duidelik stel dat indien enige skool gebruik wil maak van departementele eksamens, dit op 'n vrywillige basis moet gebeur. Dit is dus elke skool se keuse om die departementele eksamens te gebruik, of

SAOU (Limpopo) received several inquiries regarding departmental exams. It appears that some districts have decided that these exams are mandatory for all schools. It's just not true. Only underperforming schools may be required to write these exams. Attached is a letter from the department that states clearly that if any school wants to make use of departmental examinations, it must be done on a voluntary basis. It is therefore each school's choice to use the departmental (common) examinations, or to
