FOKUSAREAS VAN OPLEIDING / FOCUS AREAS OF TRAINING

LEES: DIE INVLOED VAN GENERASIES EN SLAGGATE WAARIN ONDERWYSERS GETRAP HET / READING: THE INFLUENCE OF GENERATIONS AND THE STUMBLING BLOCKS THAT TEACHERS HAVE ENCOUNTERED

Navorsing in Suid-Afrika toon dat 'n baie groot aantal laer- en hoërskoolleerders nie toereikend kan lees om bevredigend in hul skoolwerk te kan presteer nie. Wat is die wenresep? Hoe hanteer suksesvolle onderwysers die nuwe generasies wat gewoon is aan vinnige resultate, visuele inligting en toenemende korter aandagspanning het? Hierdie aanbieding fokus op lesse geleer, wenke om prestasie te verhoog en 'n positiewe werksomgewing te skep.

Research in South Africa shows that an abundant number of primary and secondary school learners cannot read adequately in order to perform satisfactory in their school work. What is the winning recipe? How do successful educators handle the new generation who is accustomed to quick results, visual information and a progressive shorter attention span. This session focus on lessons learned, tips to elevate performance and to create a positive working environment.

KURRIKULUMBOUSTENE IN DIE LAERSKOOLO: WAAR MOET DIE FOKUS LÊ? / CURRICULUM BUILDING BLOCKS IN THE PRIMARY SCHOOL. WHERE SHOULD THE FOCUS BE?

Wat is verkeerd in die Suid-Afrikaanse Onderwysstelsel? Hoe belangrik is kleiner klasgroottes, tegnologie in die klaskamers en klasassistenten vir suksesvolle onderrig? Hierdie opleiding fokus op die boustene wat in plek moet wees sodat die kurrikulum suksesvol onderrig kan word en bied ook talle wenke aan opvoeders om leerders se selfdissipline en selfmotivering aan te moedig.

What is wrong in the South African Teaching System? How important is smaller classes, technology in the classroom and classroom assistants for successful teaching? This session focuses on the building blocks that should be in place in order to teach the curriculum successfully and also offer tips to educators on how to improve learners' self-discipline and self-motivation.
