SOSIALE MEDIA – WAT IS JOU VERANTWOORDELIKHEDE?

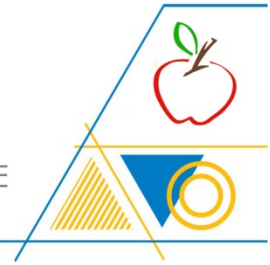

The 30 learners who perform the best in each region (linked to a university), will be invited to attend an inspiring Maths/Science Fun Day, hosted at their closest university campus. There are also cash prizes for the top learners.
