skole. Die SAOU is uiters bekommerd oor 'n aantal aspekte soos gemeenskapsvoorkeure en afkeure, ouderdoms- en geloofsensitiwiteit. Dit het onder ons aandag gekom dat een van die hoofdoelwitte is om leerderswangerskappe ( $\pm 21,000$  pj) in primêre en sekondêre skole te verminder. Dit is egter op hierdie stadium baie moeilik om kommentaar te lewer aangesien die inhoud van die kurrikulum nog nie bekend gemaak is aan die betrokke partye nie. Die SAOU sal egter deurgaans betrokke wees en lede op hoogte hou van die jongste verwickelinge.

Die DBO het die sperdatum vir geskrewe kommentaar op die nasionale beleid oor die voorkoming en bestuur van leerlingwangerskappe in skole tot einde Julie verleng. Alhoewel dié beleid oënskynlik net handel oor die voorkoming en bestuur van leerlingwangerskappe, bind dit skole tot die onderrig van die nuwe voorgestelde, omvattende seksualiteitsopvoeding as deel van die KABV-verklaring. Die DBO voer aan dat die doel van die beoogde omvattende seksualiteitsopvoeding is onder meer om jong mense te leer om respek vir mekaar te hê en gesonde keuses oor seksualiteit te maak. Met die voorgestelde beleid poog hul ook om die hoë MIV-syfer en hoë getalle van tienerswangerskappe in Suid-Afrika aan te spreek.

## SENIORFASE PROMOSIEVEREISTES

Na afloop van die vereiste konsultasieproses, het die DBO verlede week bekend gemaak dat die bestaande progressie- en promosievereistes, soos uiteengesit in die Nasionale Kurrikulum Beleidsverklaring Graad R-12 ([Staatkoerant 34600](#), [Kennisgewings 722 and 723 of 12 September 2011](#)), steeds vir 2018 van toepassing is. Die wysigings soos in [Omsendskrywe Nr 3 van 2015](#) en [Nr 3 van 2016](#) is ook steeds van toepassing.

Huidige Promosievereistes van toepassing:

Voldoen aan die bevorderingsvereistes in agt (8) van die vakke, mits die skoolgebaseerde assesseringskomponent van die negende vak afgehandel is:

- 50% in een taal op Huistaalvlak;
- 40% in die tweede vereiste amptelike taal op Eerste Addisionele Taalvlak.
- 40% in Suid-Afrikaanse Gebaretaal op Huistaalvlak), indien geneem deur dowe leerders in plaas van 'n amptelike taal op Eerste Addisionele Taalvlak;
- 40% in Wiskunde (verpligtend);
- 40% in enige drie (3) van die ander vereiste vakke; en
- 30% in enige twee (2) van die ander vakke.
- Dowe leerders, wat nie Suid-Afrikaanse Gebaretaal op Huistaalvlak neem nie, mag 30% in een van die twee vereiste amptelike tale verwerf.



## KABV KURRIKULUM VOORGESTELDE VERANDERINGE

Na herhaalde klagtes vanuit onderwysgeledere oor die oormatige lading ten opsigte van die kurrikuluminhoud asook die aantal voorgeskrewe SBA-take het verskeie rolspelers bymekaar gekom om voorgestelde veranderinge aan Hoofstuk 4 van die KABV-kurrikulum te bespreek. Die voorgestelde veranderinge is op 19 Julie 2018 aan die Komitee van Onderwysministers voorgelê vir goedkeuring. Daar word tans gewag op die uitreiking van die amptelike inligting vanaf die Departement van Basiese Onderwys vir publieke kommentaar.

**Hiermee 'n ernstige pleidooi: Daar gaan slegs 21 dae vir publieke kommentaarlewering gegun word – om 'n verskil te maak om die onderhandelingsstafel, word elke SAOU lid se inset dringend benodig.** Hou asseblief kommunikasie van die SAOU dop rakende hierdie kwessie wat ons nie sonder u hulp kan aanspreek nie.

## GESKIEDENIS AS VERPLIGTE VAK

Op 25 Julie het die SAOU die kwartaallikse kurrikulumvergaderings by die Departement van Basiese Onderwys bygewoon. Twee belangrike kwessies wat tydens die Onderwysers-ontwikkeling Kurrikulumbestuur en die Nasionale Assesseringskomiteevergaderings bespreek is, is die kwessies rakende Lewensoriëntering en Geskiedenis in die VOO-fase. Die aanbevelings wat voorheen deur twee ministeriële taakspanne ontvang is, is bespreek. Die vergadering het die belangrikheid van Lewensoriëntering as 'n essensiële deel van 'n leerder se opvoeding bevestig. Leerders, as hoof van huishoudings, sowel as ander leerders, is uiters kwesbaar en benodig lewensvaardighede om hul veranderende en uitdagende omgewing te hanteer om sodoende die regte besluite te neem. Die belangrikheid van Lewensoriëntering om 10 krediete te verdien as deel van die NSS-vereiste, is ook bevestig. Die konsensus van hierdie vergadering was dat Lewensoriëntering tot graad 12 moet bly.

Die Ministeriële Taakspan oor Geskiedenis het egter die afronding van Lewensoriëntering en die infasering van Geskiedenis as 'n verpligte vak in 2023-2025 aanbeveel. Die aanbeveling sou wees dat Geskiedenis 'n verpligte vak tot graad 12 word, wat tot verhoogde kontaktyd, van 27.5 uur tot 29.5 uur per week, sal lei. Die voltooiing van die Nasionale Senior Sertifikaat benodig 130 krediete. Die uitfasering van Lewensoriëntering en akkumulering van 130 krediete sal dus in effek 'n probleem skep. Die belangrikheid van Geskiedenis kan nie ontken word nie, aangesien dit 'n belangrike rol speel in nasiebou. Die verryking van die huidige KABV Geskiedenis-kurrikulum ten opsigte van dekolonisasie is erken.

## CONCERN ABOUT THE PROPOSED CSE POLICY

Recently, the SAOU received a number of enquiries in regard to the proposed Comprehensive Sexuality Education (CSE) programme in public schools. The SAOU is very concerned about a

number of aspects including community preferences and denouncements, sensitivity around age and religion. It has come to our attention that one of the DBE's main objectives is to curb the prevalence of learner pregnancies ( $\pm 21,000$  pa) in primary and secondary schools. It is however, difficult to comment at this stage because the content of the document has not yet been shared with all relevant parties. The SAOU will endeavour to ensure participation and will keep members abreast of unfolding developments.

Like several other role-players, the SAOU insisted on a fair consultation process regarding the curriculum and is currently in contact with the Department of Basic Education on the matter. A further plea from the SAOU is that communities be allowed to apply this policy at their own discretion.

The DBE extended the date for public comment on The Prevention and Management of Learner Pregnancy in Schools Policy to the end of July. Even though this policy is apparently about the handling and management of teenage pregnancies in schools, it does however commit schools to teaching the new proposed comprehensive sexuality education program as part of the CAPS statement. According to the DBE the aim of this is to teach learners to respect each other and make good decisions in regard to sexuality. With this they also attempt to address the high HIV numbers and rising numbers of teenage pregnancies in South Africa.

## PROMOTION REQUIREMENTS IN THE SENIOR PHASE

After the completion of the required consultation process, DBE decided that the current promotion requirement should be retained, but would be reviewed again in the future.

The progression and promotion criteria that will apply are those that were published as part of the National Curriculum Statement, Grades R-12 which was approved as National Policy and published in the [Government Gazette 34600, Notices 722 and 723 of 12 September 2011](#).

The requirements as stated in, [Circular No. 3 of 2015](#) and [Circular No. 3 of 2016](#) will still apply.

Current Promotion Requirements:

Satisfy the promotion requirements in eight (8) of the subjects, provided the School-Based Assessment component of the ninth subject has been completed:

- 50% in one language at Home Language level;
- 40% in the second required official language at First Additional Language level.
- 40% in South African Sign Language at Home Language level), if offered by Deaf learners in lieu of an official language at First Additional Language level;





- 40% in Mathematics (compulsory);
- 40% in any three (3) of the other required subjects; and
- 30% in any two (2) of the other subjects.
- Deaf learners, who do not offer South African Sign Language at Home Language level, may obtain 30% in one of the two required official languages.

## PROPOSED CAPS CURRICULUM CHANGES

After countless complaints from key role players in education, several role players met to discuss possible amendments to Chapter 4 of the CAPS Curriculum Statement. This was done in an attempt to address the overload of the prescribed content prescribed as well as the number of SBA tasks required. According to the planning framework rolled out by the Department of Basic Education these proposed amendments were scheduled for publication on 10 July, but were only presented to the CEM committee on 19 July.

Currently, we are still awaiting an official announcement from the DBE, but once those documents are published for public comment **we only have 21 days to comment** and we will need your input. **Please keep an eye out for communication related to this issue as we cannot address this without you. Help us, help you!**

## HISTORY AS COMPULSORY SUBJECT

On the 25th of July the SAOU attended the quarterly curriculum meeting held under the auspices of the Department of Basic Education. The joint Teacher Development Curriculum Management and National Education Assessment Committee meetings dealt with two very current and important issues relating to Life Orientation and History in the FET phase. The recommendations previously received by two Ministerial Task Teams, were discussed.

The meeting confirmed the importance of Life Orientation as a vital part of a learner's education. Learners, who are heads of households, as well as other learners, are extremely vulnerable and need life skills to cope with their changing and challenging environment and continuously endeavour to make the right decisions. The importance of Life Orientation in accruing 10 credits as part of the NSC requirement was also confirmed. The consensus of this meeting was that Life Orientation must remain up to Grade 12.

However, the Ministerial Task team on History recommended the phasing out of Life Orientation and phasing in of History as a compulsory subject in 2023 - 2025. The recommendation would be that History will become a compulsory subject up to Grade 12

which will result in increased notional time from 27.5 hours to 29.5 hours per week. The fulfilment of the National Senior Certificate requires 130 credits. The phasing out of Life Orientation will in effect create a problem in accumulating the 130 credits. The importance of History cannot be denied as it plays a significant role in nation building. The enrichment of the current CAPS History curriculum towards decolonisation was acknowledged.

This current situation of contradicting recommendations urges us to call for your input on the matter as it effects our members. The SAOU requests your urgent attention to this very important issue as a final response must be submitted on 30 September 2018 to the Department of Basic Education.
